The oceanographic Museum of Monaco is settled into the summer and offers you the opportunity to enrich your visit with many activities. Every day, from 10:00 a.m. to 8:30 p.m., enjoy a magnificent dive into the marine world...

10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. > Shark touch pool

Rendezvous at the Hall Entrance (level 0)

Respectfully and gently, come take advantage of a privileged contact with the sharks! Guided by our staff, you can touch the back or the side of a Pyjama shark, a striped Leopard shark or a starry smooth-hound. You will never forget this experience.

11:00 a.m. > Fish snack

Rendezvous at the Aquarium (level -1)

Do not miss the daily meal of our residents. Spend a spectacular and interactive moment with our experts. Seated in front of the aquarium, eyes riveted on the fish, the children will not miss a thing.

12:00 p.m., 3:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. > Discovery visit of the "Sharks" exhibition

Rendezvous at the Whale Room (level 1)

Who are they? Where do they live? Are they dangerous? From the tip of their teeth to their fins, from the Mediterranean all the way to the other side of the world, a member of our staff will help you discover the many sides of these mysterious predators. During the visit, you will virtually dive with the sharks and touch with the tip of your fingers the fascinating world of these feared yet fragile animals: between Man and shark, the predator is not so obvious...

1:00 p.m., 2:00 p.m., 3:00 p.m., 4:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. > The touch pool!*

Rendezvous at the Reception Area (level 0)

Get closer to starfish, feel the spine of sea urchins, pet a Mediterranean baby shark... For 45 minutes, with the help of our staff, you can learn using your hands!

Rendezvous on the Terrace (level 2)

Who's hiding behind the third largest shell in the world? Come and explore the lives of these creatures on our panoramic terrace. A member of our staff will reveal the particularities of the spurred tortoises that have lived for centuries and are now endangered species.

 **11:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. > The Sea Cinema**

Come and explore a remarkable programming of films revolving around the "Sharks" exhibition to better get acquainted with these lords of the oceans.
